Merry Christmas!

I hope that this letter finds you well and enjoying the holiday season. I can hardly believe that the time for preparing for the 2024 ASP trip is upon us. This summer will be Faith's 38th time sending volunteers for the amazing experience that is Appalachia Service Project. ASP provides an opportunity for senior high youth to put their faith into action, to be "doers" rather than "talkers" as they respond to the housing needs of rural Appalachia in a tangible way. We are registered for **week 5**, so we will **leave July 6th (Saturday) and return on July 13th (Saturday)**. At this time, we do not know where we will be sent. They typically assign us a location much closer to our departure date.

Because this trip is one where teamwork is integral, the youth who participate will be expected to take an active part in several group fundraising activities, service projects, and study sessions. There will be several opportunities to volunteer. The goal is for each youth to have a total of 6 service hours. This helps us arrive on site ready to do our best to serve those we meet and each other. The cost of the trip is \$250 per volunteer. The costs for participation, including meals, transportation, construction supplies and the annual ASP t-shirt are included. The only other expense would be discretionary spending money for your youth while on the trip. Also supporting the ASP Mission Team are Faith's mission budget, United Women in Faith, and a very generous congregation.

The signed Covenant for the youth and completed ASP Volunteer Statement/Registration form and Medical Information Form, accompanied with \$250 Participation Fee or \$100 (non-refundable) if paying by installments, are due by Sunday, February 25, 2024 to the church office. A limited number of scholarships are available to assist in defraying cost; contact Mieke Blackwell (mieke@champaignfaith.org) for more information.

In order to be guaranteed a spot on the team, all paperwork and the \$100 deposit must be turned in by February 25th. This includes a completed volunteer registration form with tetanus shot date, a signed youth covenant, and a copy of your insurance card. The volunteer registration form should be signed and dated, but you do not need to notarize it. The church office will take care of the notarization. Also, on the back of the youth covenant, all youth should submit a paragraph explaining why they want to serve on the ASP team.
